

STORM PROCEDURE BEFORE & AFTER

Severe hail, thunder, or wind checklist.

Follow these steps in the event a severe storm is forecasted to affect your area. Use this worksheet to ensure your checking all the boxes when it comes to reducing the impact of extreme weather.

BEFORE THE STORM HITS

Listen to weather alerts in your area. Keep a battery-powered radio on hand for updates.

Shelter outdoor items. Bring in anything that has the potential to be damaged by hail or wind (outdoor furniture, signage, awnings, umbrellas, etc.).

Be prepared for possible outages. It is never a bad idea to have a generator on hand to provide temporary power.

Secure and tightly close windows. If you can, use a tarp, drape, or even wood to barricade the windows to protect the interior of your establishment from broken glass, flying debris, or hailstones.

REMINDERS DURING THE SEASON

Keep trees around your establishment trimmed. This will prevent the risk of falling limbs and debris damaging your location.

Keep all gutters and drain pipes clear of debris. This will prevent additional water damage.

Evaluate the condition of your roof and HVAC. Identify if there is damage and prevent further deterioration.

OBTAIN PRIOR TO FILING A CLAIM:

- ▶ Document damages
- ▶ Take photos and video of damages
- ▶ Retain all records of costs associated with board up and mitigation
